Summary: was great if this project did not need to be presented. However; in this difficult time widespread hunger according the World Food Program threatens the immediate survival of around 6 million people in the country. According to different reports; Afghanistan has one of the highest rate of addicted and disability rate in the World and still is severely on prevalent. Disabled and addicted People are the country’s most vulnerable citizens, among other social problems, suffer from ongoing neglect, stigmatization and discrimination. Disabled and addicted men, women and children are often excluded from humanitarian assistance specially from food distribution. They suffer from exploitation, violence, and physical abuse.

Over 40 years of protracted war, approximately 2 million Afghans have addiction related problems, amputated limbs or other mobility, visual, or hearing disabilities, and many Afghans also suffer from mental health conditions.

Our Soup-Kitchen service at lowest overhead cost close to non

The number of population who has no stable housing to prepare hot meal for themselves has escalated in Herat City, and hunger is a constant problem for this group and for others in the city. Numerous of non-governmental organization, international agencies, and local charities have responded by establishing to the hunger problem. but; due to beneficiary assessment, registration and selection requirement & procedure many of homeless, street children and addicted population have not benefited from food assistance to fight hunger. Therefore; AFPO

initiated soup-kitchen services with a diet quality food menu to contributes to optimal Nutrient Intake for those who has not stable housing to benefit from food distribution in Herat.

The meal provided in the kitchen follows nutritional quality and standards of food preparation. Those meals offered fresh vegetables (cabbage, tomatoes, cucumber, carrots) fruits, rice, and chicken or red kidney beans. The current menu is made due to cash donations was available during menu planning.

With broad simple management and clear mission AFPO tries to minimize the administration cost of the project. Plan a budget that reflects priorities. Carefully develop a patron's relations to minimize labor and product costs. Assign qualified and dedicated staff to the jobs, buy raw materials from barging market, and prepare the meal close to the communities to avoid city bus transport cost to the beneficiaries and commodities cost for the kitchen. Also AFPO pays minimum wages to the project staff only. After set-up cost the kitchen provide best quality food menu (rice, chicken or red beans, vegetable, fruit, spices, sanitary service) at the cost of \$1 per person.
